Name, surname, year of birth, country, team. All participants must submit 1 photo for ID card for entrance in the hall; it should be submitted to the organizers until March 25, included, but preferably as soon as possible.

Participants who are not citizens of Latvia – copy of passport.

Registration of foreign participants until March 12, payment of participation fee should be performed 2 hours (1 hour for ED group) before the start.

Participants who need to receive visa for participation in the competition should remember that it takes time, and therefore, please, sent the data required for invitation until March 1(see <u>Appendix 1</u>). All expenses connected with processing of invitation and visas are covered by the participants.

7 Participation fee:

8 Determination of the winners – form of the competition

Start at the elimination is open and joint for the whole group. The participant should manage as many routes as possible within time set by referees.

In the final the routes are closed and the participants go into the routes alone. Time of attempt is equal with the resting time. Mechanism for determination of results will be updated maintaining the abovementioned principles.

9 Objections

Should be submitted not later than $\frac{1}{2}$ hour after announcement of results. Fee for review of the objection is 25 LVL.

10 Distribution of prizes:

In groups ED, CB first three places will be awarded with diplomas and memento prizes. In group A, money prizes with the total fund of 600 LVL (850 EUR). In the amateur group first three places will receive memento prizes, but within the whole group one main prize will be drawn in groups of men and women.

11 Additional information:

The competition will be held in compliance with the "<u>Competition regulations for climbing sports</u>" approved by the Latvian Alpinists Association (LAA).
